# **Tuition Information**

### **Application Deposit: \$200**

A deposit is required with the submission of your application. We accept cash, money orders, or checks. Please make checks payable to: Banyan Farm. If accepted, your deposit will go towards your tuition fee and is NON-REFUNDABLE. If you are not accepted into the program, your deposit will be fully refunded.

### Tuition: \$2800 for a shared room in the straw bale constructed house OR \$2600 for camping

Please indicate whether you have a preference for a \_ shared room, \_ camping spot, or \_ either, pending availability. There is an Early Bird discount of \$200 for those who pay tuition in full by February 1st, 2024. Tuition is due in full by June 1st, 2024. If tuition is not paid by this date, your position will be offered to a wait-list applicant.

#### **Refund Policy**

Before June 15th, 2024, students that withdraw may be refunded 25% of their tuition. After June 15th, 2024, there are no refunds.



## Banyan Farm ("Land-based Resiliency Course") Program Policies

Banyan Farm and ("Participant") enter into an educational arrangement for the purpose of Participant gaining valuable educational and hands-on experience related to land-based resiliency practices and both parties agree to the terms and agreements outlined:

**Term:** Land-based resiliency courses run for 2-week periods only one time each year. The course may not be extended beyond the defined dates of each 2-week program.

### Additional Terms:

- We will provide lodging in the straw bale constructed house or a camping spot to the participant during the term of the internship. Lodging will be shared between participants.
- b. We cannot accommodate pets, children, or partners.
- c. Because of the close living arrangements, we cannot allow anyone to participate who has been diagnosed or suspects to have a communicable health condition (e.g. malaria, MRSA, pneumonia, smallpox, etc.).
- d. We will eat seasonal, homegrown, whole, organic, and sustainable foods.
- e. Due to the nature of the program, we don't permit the use of alcohol and other mind-altering substances.
